


CreaTV San Jose

Each participant will have access to our professional community media team and resources.


This will include the production equipment, technical training, and mentoring needed to develop artistic and media making skills so they might bring the spirit of innovation and empowerment home to their communities.




More Más Marami

They produce innovative productions, script readings, open mics, educational workshops, and opportunities for and with underserved communities of San Jose and the South Bay Area.





Digital Media Academy

Through their professional consulting services, DCCC provides inclusive and organic learning that they inherited from our ancestors.



The center houses a gymnasium, fitness room, health and social services wing, and an on-site medical clinic.


YTI will offer closed specialized workshops to the Columbia Neighborhood Center Youth Cohort.

Fentanyl Takes Friends

In 2019, there were 71,000 drug overdose deaths in the US, most of which were from fentanyl or other synthetic opioids. Drug overdoses are now the leading cause of injury-related deaths - almost twice as many as people die from drug overdoses than are killed in car accidents.

Many drug dealers mix the much cheaper fentanyl into other drugs like heroin, cocaine, MDMA (ecstasy/molly), and methamphetamine to increase their profits.
